MESSAGE FROM SEDP INC.

President & CEO, Rev. Fr. Jose Victor Lobrigo of SEDP Inc. greeted the body and said that he requested to be the first one to give a message because he just landed from Zamboanga City and still have some appointments later on.

Fr. Lobrigo referred the assembly to the previous Annual General meeting minutes on page 15 wherein he recalled that he cited some factors that could help in alleviating the local economic aspects of members. Fr. Lobrigo said, SEDP Inc. is in partnership with other agencies like the Social Action Center, in order to help the economic status of members through its program and services. Also, SEDP Inc. had formulated a policy for associate membership in order to extend the benefits to other members of the family. In addition, Fr. Lobrigo also stated that SEDP Inc. had also other benefit which is called SEDP Care which has a tag line of "Sagot kita hanggang langit". And for the next year highlights Fr. Lobrigo said that SEDP Care Program will be extended to Caritas Diocese of Libmanan (CDL).

Still, Fr. Lobrigo also announced that upon implementation of SEDP Care Program, all members who are already 66 years old and above will be given SEDP Care Lifetime Certificate which will be distributed during area gathering. With this, SEDP Inc. and SEDP MBA will have cost sharing of fund requirement for the implementation of the SEDP Care Program as additional benefits of members.



Fr. Lobrigo also announced the new challenge for the microfinance members, he said that presently the Microfinance Council of the Philippines (MCPI) had launched MIDAS – a database of all network member MFI comprised of all the profile of MFI members. With the database anyone can verify if an MFI member is also a member of other MFI at the same time. One of the objectives of MIDAS is to avoid multiple memberships and help the member to decide of which MFI they retain membership.

Further, the MCPI has a mandate that members should have a representation in the MFIs Board of Trustees for them to be aware on how MFI is being managed. Fr. Lobrigo emphasized that it is stated in the microfinance law that members should have a representation in the MFIs BOT. Also, the Microfinance Council of the Philippines also require each MFI to ensure the financial sustainability of each member, and as far as social performance is concern, every MFI should have value added services to its members as Fr. Lobrigo stated. With MIDAS implementation, Fr. Lobrigo said that SEDP Inc. will conduct Policies & Regulations - Information and Education Campaign to members.

Other announcement of Fr. Lobrigo was the proposed conduct of Joint SEDP MBA and SEDP Inc. Annual General Assembly which will be scheduled every last week of May of every year. This will be implemented once amendments of both By Laws of said institutions were approved by the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). On enterprise development, Fr. Lobrigo announced that on Dec. 3, 2019 there will be a blessing of the "Babuyang Walang Amoy" particularly in the areas of Anislag, Daraga; Putiao, and Castilla Sorsogon. Lastly, Fr. Lobrigo encouraged the members to call or text to the cellphone number provided in the tarpaulin and flyers if there are queries, comments or suggestions to further improve delivery of programs and services of the institution.

WELCOME REMARKS

The SEDP MBA BOT Vice – President, Ms. Remegia Balucio gave the welcome remarks.

Ms. Balucio said that SEDP MBA has increasing membership since 2010 until its 9th year of operation. She said that there are some members who preferred to enrol first in social protection or insurance rather than availing loans. With this membership of SEDP MBA is increasing because of the associate members who chose to have first social protections rather than loans.

Still, Ms. Balucio guaranteed the members that their premium contributions in SEDP MBA is well handled and well managed by the Board of Trustees and Management of SEDP MBA. In return Ms. Balucio emphasized that members can expect more and better services from SEDP MBA with provision of more additional benefits. With this, Ms. Balucio requested the members to still patronize the services of SEDP MBA.

The internal audit counted the solid votes of 167 without any who dissented and abstained.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Fr. Rex Paul Arjona, President delivered his Report

The following summary of 2017 Board of Trustees Resolutions was presented by Fr. Arjona for ratification by the assembly.

After the presentation there being no comments and clarifications Mr. Andres Paclibar moved to ratify the summary of Board of Trustees Resolutions for the year 2017. With 167 votes affirming the motion.

AGMM Res. No. 4 Series of 2018. RATIFICATION OF 2017 SUMMARY OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTIONS.

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that majority of the General Membership approved the ratification of 2017 summary of Board of Trustees Resolutions.

Moving on, Fr. Arjona assured the members that in terms of sustainability, SEDP MBA is very much sustainable and when it comes to claims benefit it is delivered within the average of three (3) days and recognizing the members' contribution in the attainment of 100% claims settlement compliant to what the regulator set. Regarding Lamay Package, Fr. Arjona said that SEDP MBA will provide multi-purpose tent to each branch as additional benefit of SEDP MBA stakeholders. The said Tent can be borrowed by the member for any kind of activities. On SEDP CARE Program, SEDP MBA will endorse all retired members from SEDP MBA for years 2016 and earlier to SEDP Inc. for the provision of Five thousand Pesos benefit.

Further, on product innovation various insurance products are in the pipeline for study in response to members' request of providing non-life products. Fr. Arjona said that the New Social Protection Products for the year 2019 includes the Personal Plan+, Pamilya Plan+, Estudyante Plan+ and the Bahay Negosyo Plan+.

A member asked Fr. Arjona why not give insurance to the Agricultural business of the members in order to address the sudden increase of prices of the prime commodities specifically the rice, instead of giving other social protection. Further, such member said that she is currently enrolled in the PCIC wherein the farms and crops businesses of the members can be insured.

Also, another member asked Fr. Arjona if what age can be enrolled in the Estudyante Plan+. In reply, Fr. Arjona said that for Estudyante Plan+ it will be the school who will enroll the child in the plan and not the SEDP MBA. Still, another member asked what if upon enrollment in the Estudyante Plan+ the child was only in the Elementary level, can it be carried thru college level? Fr. Arjona said that Estudyante Plan+ is renewable yearly.

Fr. Arjona emphasized that offering of non-life product is a collaborative effort of SEDP MFI, SEDP MPC and SEDP MBA wherein partnership to a third party insurance company will be necessary for its implementation.

In closing Fr. Arjona encourage the members to continue patronizing SEDP MBA for sustainability and stability of the programs and services provided to the members and stakeholders.

RE-APPOINTMENT OF EXTERNAL AUDITOR

Fr. Arjona explained to the assembly the regulatory requirements of the external auditor term limitation in performing external audit to a certain MBA which is a maximum of 5 years but can



be re-contracted after a year or two pause of audit for a particular MBA. This is in order that external audit activity becomes more objective and that the institution be more responsive in delivering services to its members. Fr. Arjona announced that Quilab & Garsuta is the existing external auditor of SEDP MBA which is based in Cagayan de Oro and is already in the 3rd year now of conducting external audit to SEDP MBA. With this, Fr. Arjona endorsed Quilab & Garsuta, CPA to still be the External Auditor for the year 2019.

In response from the assembly, Ms. Jean Miranda of SEDP Daraga Branch moved to approve the re-appointment of External Auditor Quilab & Garsuta, CPA. The motion was seconded by Ms. Emily Barbin of SEDP Rapu-Rapu Branch. 167 votes were obtained in favour of Quilab & Garsuta, CPAs' re-appointment.
